Bechard, Margaret. *STAR HATCHLING*. When Hanna accidentally lands on an alien planet, she encounters strange creatures and an unusual culture.

Cameron, Eleanor. *THE WONDERFUL FLIGHT TO THE MUSHROOM PLANET*. Science fiction combined with magic in the story of 2 boys who take off on a spaceship with a magical man named Tyco Bass. A very old story, but a great one.

Christopher, John. *WHEN THE TRIPODS CAME*. How the Tripods came to Earth and imposed a new order.

Christopher, John. *THE WHITE MOUNTAINS*. The first volume of a trilogy in which a young boy escapes from a futuristically mechanized tyranny.

Coville, Bruce. *MY TEACHER FRIED MY BRAINS*. Duncan is convinced his teacher is an alien when he finds a fake hand in a dumpster. (Check out more books in the *MY TEACHER IS AN ALIEN* series.)

Etra, Jonathan, and Stephanie Spinner. *ALIENS FOR BREAKFAST*. Richard meets an alien who needs help to find a secret weapon.

Etra, Jonathan, and Stephanie Spinner. *ALIENS FOR LUNCH*. Richard and Henry are called upon to help stop an evil planet's scheme to steal the dessert resources of the earth.

Griffin, Penni R. *SWITCHING WELL*. Two girls from different centuries trade places.

Heinlein Robert. *CITIZEN OF THE GALAXY*. The only life Thorby has known is as a slave on a distant planet; then his adopted 'father' dies and he discovers he has a famous heritage on earth.

Heinlein Robert. *PODKAYNE OF MARS*. A girl raised on Mars travels back to Earth with her Uncle and pesky little brother; then danger looms.

Hoover, H.M. *ONLY CHILD*. Gody, who has lived all of his 12 years on a spaceship, is captured by alien creatures in the earthlike planet of Patma.

Katz, Welwyn W. *TIME GHOST*. In a heavily polluted 21st-century environment, Sara time-travels to the 1990s, when the world was still green.

Key, Alexander. *THE FORGOTTEN DOOR*. When little Jon falls to earth from another planet, he encounters suspicion and hostility as well as sympathy.

Klause, Annette Curtis. *ALIEN SECRETS*. On a spaceship to see her parents, Robin finds herself involved in a murder and a mystery involving an alien named Hush.

L'Engle, Madeleine. *A WRINKLE IN TIME*. A provocative tale of a brother and sister in search of their father, who is lost in the fifth dimension.

Morris, Gilbert. *THE DANGEROUS VOYAGE*. In order to help their ailing young brother, twins Danny and Dixie volunteer to travel through time in this book, the first of the series.

O'Brien, Robert. *MRS. FRISBY AND THE RATS OF NIMH*. Having no one to help her with her problems, a widowed mouse turns to a colony of very special wise and long-lived rats. Sequels are by Jane Conly.

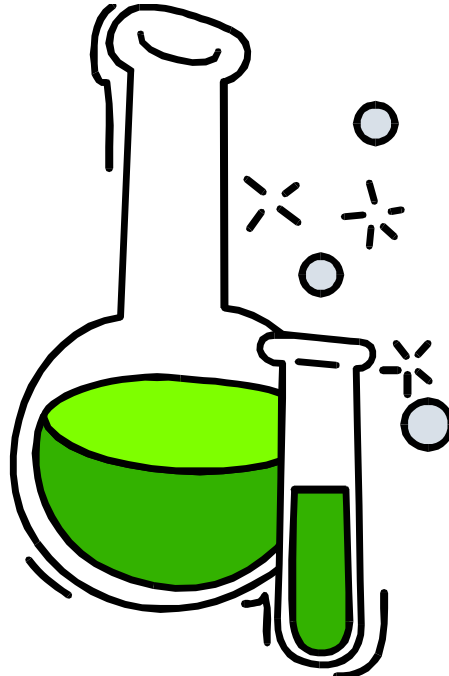
